From Michael Melanson concerning his wife Betty (both GCI

members living in Riverview, NB). "I am resending this prayer request, with a couple of things added into it. We have received the results of Betty's recent diagnostic scan, and I want to make you aware of the results. The scan shows what are described as 3 small nonspecific nodules in different areas of the lungs, and also some lung scarring which is normally associated with asbestos exposure sometime in life, and a small nodule was observed in the left lobe of her thyroid.

There is also what was described as minimal fluid buildup in the pericardium sack in the front of her heart. Betty is also finding herself getting winded and being short of breath very easily, which should not be occurring.

Another scan has been recommended for 6 to 9 months time to keep an eye on them. We are praying that they do not enlarge, and also that by God's grace they may ultimately shrink and disappear. Obviously prayers from the brethren would be appreciated."
